The Palo Alto Mediation Program (PAMP) assists residents in resolving disputes under terms they control, instead of going to court or doing nothing. Typical cases include tenant/landlord, neighbor/neighbor, consumer, workplace, and other disputes. The program services are free and are available to anyone who lives, works, or owns property in Palo Alto. All who live or work in Palo Alto or Stanford are invited to apply.

WHAT IS EXPECTED FROM PAMP MEDIATORS?

Mediators typically spend six to ten hours each month working on various aspects of the mediation process – case development, conciliation, mediation, serving on committees and attending evening program meetings on the third Thursday of the month.

APPLY

Successful applicants must complete a 36-hour community mediation training by the start of their two-year term in July. There is a course offered by Mediation 2.0 in April that meets this requirement. The training is free of cost.
